Meeting not quorate but opportunity taken to discuss the following matters not requiring a formal discussion:

- Mid Wales Priorities and Delivery Plan 2022/23 – Update noted for information.
- Mid Wales Priorities 2023/24 - Feedback was received on the Mid Wales Planning and Delivery Executive Planning workshop held on 27th February 2023. The group noted that the top 3 clinical priorities, which they had previously agreed upon, were included in the priorities for 2023/24.
- Urology - Latest update on work being undertaken on the development of a Mid Wales urology pathway received. Noted that the national work on the development of an All Wales pathway was nearing completion and the Mid Wales work needed to link with this. The chair of the group is reviewing the responses received from GP practices on the current systems which they have in place for monitoring of PSA levels. The date for the second workshop has been arranged for 2nd May 2023.
- Aberystwyth University School of Nursing – An update was received on the future increase in nurse training courses being provided at Aberystwyth University with the number of students due to increase from 50 to 186 in September 2023. This was due to an increase in the number of Adult and Mental Health nursing places from 50 to 70 as from September 2023, commencement of the part time Adult and Mental Health nursing course in June 2023 and the introduction of the level 4 programme with 62 places for health care support workers (for both health and social care).
- Mid Wales Vascular pathways – Issues were raised with regards to the vascular pathway across Mid Wales. There was a need to clarify the boundaries and who was responsible for making sure that referrals were sent to the correct vascular unit. The group agreed that a meeting be arranged of Cluster leads, Commissioning teams and representatives of the BCUHB Vascular team which was held on 12th April 2023.
- Innovation strategy for Wales – It was agreed that Health Boards and Local Authorities were to be asked what work they would be undertaking to implement the strategy for reporting back to the group.
- Trusted Assessors - The All Wales Trusted Assessor model was currently under development, however, concerns were raised that this model could be applied in a different way across Wales and working cross border at a regional level could potentially be a challenge. It was agreed that the Chair would write to the Mid Wales Social Care

Group to ask that they scope this out to see what potential issues there may be for reporting back to the Clinical Advisory Group.

- Symptomatic FIT tests - Contact details for Powys Teaching Health Board and national leads for the roll out of symptomatic FIT tests had been provided to the GP Cluster Lead for North Ceredigion.
- Nurse and Therapy Director representation – It was noted that Directors of Nursing and Therapies had not always been able to field regular representation at meetings. Members felt it was important to have nurse and therapy representation at the group in order to ensure all clinical groups were represented. The group agreed that a message be sent to Directors of Nursing and Directors of Therapies advising them that if they were unable to attend future meetings then they would be welcome to ask a representative to attend on their behalf.
